HORNDEN is a civil parish formed under the provisions of the County of Southampton Review Order, 1932, comprising the former parishes of Blendworth and Catherington. It is in the Petersfield division of the county, county court district,

petty sessional division and rural district of Petersfield. The area is 5,108 acres; the population in 1931 was 2,090. Blendworth and Catherington are ecclesiastical parishes and will be found under their own heading.

HOUGHTON (consisting of the tithings of North Houghton and Houghton Drayton) is a village and parish on the river Test, $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles north from Horsebridge station on the Andover and Redbridge branch of the Southern railway, 2 south from Stockbridge and 8 north from Romsey, in the Basingstoke division of the county, King's Somborne and Buddlegate hundreds, Romsey petty sessional division and county court district, Romsey and Stockbridge rural district, rural deanery of Romsey and archdeaconry and diocese of Winchester. Electricity is available. The church of All Saints, originally Norman, is a plain but ancient structure of flint, in the Early English style, consisting of chancel, nave, aisles, south porch and a low wooden belfry with spire, containing 3 bells, the smallest of which was recast: the shingled spire was added in 1890: there are two hagioscopes, one piercing the easternmost half pier of the nave and the other the east wall of the north aisle: there are also three piscinae: an organ was provided in 1898: the church was restored in 1875 and 1882, and affords 160 sittings. The register dates from the year 1669. The living is a rectory, net income £619,

with residence, in the gift of the Lord Chancellor and held since 1936 by the Rev. Leonard Godfrey Pears M.A. of Oxford University. A charity of £2 6s. 8d. yearly, left by Mr. Pemberton for the poor of this parish, is paid on St. George's day, and distributed by the rector and trustees. There is a small Methodist chapel, erected in 1833. Near the church is a Wayside Cross, erected in memory of those who fell in the Great War, 1914-18. The Stockbridge Fishing Association owns certain fishing rights here. The principal landowners are C. R. Fairey esq. and the trustees of St. John's Hospital, Winchester. The soil is loam, chalk and a little peat; sub-soil, chalk. The chief crops are wheat, barley and roots. The area is 2,639 acres of land, chiefly arable, and 33 of water; the population in 1931 was 373.

HOUND and NETLEY ABBEY.

HOUND is a parish and village on the banks of Southampton Water, with a station called "Netley" on the Southern railway, equidistant from Netley Abbey and Hound, and is $3\frac{1}{2}$ miles south-east-by-east from Southampton, in the Winchester division of the county, hundred of Mansbridge, rural district of Winchester, petty sessional division of Eastleigh county court district and rural deanery of Southampton and archdeaconry and diocese of Winchester. Gas and electricity are available. Water is supplied by the Southampton Corporation. The old church of St. Mary, at Hound, is a building of stone, in the Early English style, consisting of chancel, nave, south porch and a tower containing 3 bells. In 1922 the church was restored by public subscription, and at the same time a new vestry was built by the Rev. W. E. Henty-Summers as a memorial to his mother. In the churchyard is a granite cross on a square base bearing the names of those men of the parish who fell in the Great War, 1914-18. The new church of St. Edward the Confessor, erected in 1885-6, and now the parish church, is an edifice of stone, consisting of chancel, nave, south porch and an embattled eastern tower, with pinnacles, containing 8 bells: it will seat about 300 persons. The register dates from the year 1792. The living is a vicarage, net yearly value £388, including 18 acres of glebe, with residence, in the gift of the Warden and Fellows of Winchester College, and held since 1916 by the Rev. William

Edgar Henty-Summers M.A. of Trinity College, Cambridge. By the church steps is an oak gateway in memory of the men of the parish who fell in the Great War, 1914-18. The abbey of SS. Mary and Edward was founded by Henry III. in 1237 and colonized by the Cistercians of Beaulieu; the church, when perfect, consisted of presbytery of four bays, transepts with eastern chapels, two in each, nave of eight bays, and a central tower, and measured internally was about 215 feet long by 58 feet wide, across nave and aisles, with a transept 120 feet in length: the ruins are still extensive, and include the whole of the church except the north arm of the transept, and on the east side of the cloister-garth, 115 feet square, the sacristy, the chapter house, 33 by 35 feet, the common house, about 70 by 25 feet, and originally vaulted in two alleys, and adjoining it on the south a room 50 feet by 18 feet 6 inches, with a fine hooded fire-place of Early English date: on the south side is the Early English door of the refectory, with remains of the lavatory, and on the west side the porter's lodge: at the Dissolution there were 12 monks and revenues estimated at £100. The Abbey was transferred in 1922 to the guardianship of H.M. Office of Works by the late Tankerville Chamberlayne esq. and extensive restorations were carried out by that body.

The Royal Victoria Hospital, a noble and very extensive building, was erected in 1866-63, at a cost of over £400,000,
