This is the last Will and Testament of me
Alice Annie Wilkin

Lancaster

I being of legal age and sound mind I appoint my nephew James Bernard Malkin of Edderscliffe Morecambe my executor I direct the payment of my debts funeral and testamentary expenses I bequeath to my nephew Leonard Laidy Wilkin of 106 Kensington Avenue East Ham London the sum of Fifty pounds sterling free of legacy duty I bequeath to my daughter Hilba Mary Wilkin of 107 Highgate Bridge London the sum of Fifty pounds sterling free of legacy duty I bequeath to my daughter Isabel Maud Wilkin of Trenwith Mabe Cornwall Fifty pounds sterling free of legacy duty I bequeath to my sister Sarah Ellen Malkin of Edderscliffe Holmwood Morecambe the sum of Two hundred pounds sterling and my personal effects and to my nephew James Bernard Malkin the sum of Fifty pounds sterling I give to each of my brothers Ralph Birchlow Hall of 28 Duke Street Teuton Robert Hall of Regina Auckland New Zealand and James Hall of Warkworth New Zealand one third of the remainder of my estate Should my brother James not survive me then my other two said brothers Ralph Birchlow and Robert shall each receive half of his share If Ralph Birchlow or Robert does not survive me then their children shall receive their father's share each share being equally divided amongst the respective children of each father If at the time of my death it is not known where my brother James is my executor shall advertise for him in the principal newspapers of New Zealand and if at the end of two years he has not been discovered his share shall be disposed of as though he were dead I revoke all prior Wills and declare this to be my last Will It witnesses my hand this twenty sixth day of July Nine hundred and nineteen
