This is the last Will and Testament of me

Walter Frederick Statham of Beech Bank Ulverston in the
 County of Lancaster Engineer I appoint my wife Gertrude Annie Statham
 and my brothers Richard Twemlow Statham and Arthur Percy Statham
 (hereinafter called my Trustees) to be the Executors and Trustees of this my
 Will I give all my plate linen china glass books pictures prints furniture
 and other household effects unto my wife the said Gertrude Annie Statham
 absolutely I devise and bequeath all my real and personal estate not
 hereby otherwise disposed of unto my Trustees Upon trust that my Trustees
 should sell call in and convert into money the same or such part thereof
 as shall not consist of money and shall out of the moneys produced by
 such sale calling in and conversion and out of my ready money pay my
 funeral and testamentary expenses and debts and shall invest the residue
 of the said moneys with power for my Trustees from time to time at
 their discretion to vary such investments And shall stand possessed of
 the residue of the said moneys and the investments for the time being
 representing the same (hereinafter called the residuary trust fund) upon
 the trusts following (that is to say) Upon trust to pay out of the
 income thereof a sum of One hundred and fifty pounds by equal
 yearly payments to my said wife during her life if she shall so
 long remain my widow, but if she shall marry again then from and
 after her second marriage I direct my trustees to pay to my wife during
 the rest of her life out of the income of my residuary trust fund the
 sum of Fifty pounds per annum by equal yearly payments
 the first of such payments to be made at the expiration of twelve
 calendar months from the date of such marriage And with respect to the
 remainder of the said income to employ the same or such portion thereof
 as may in the absolute discretion of my trustees be necessary for the
 maintenance education and support of my children until they shall
 respectively attain the age of twenty one years and as my said children shall
 respectively attain the age of twenty one years to pay a proportionate part
 according to the number of my children of such portion of my income as is
 not paid to my said wife as hereinbefore provided to my said children as
 they respectively attain the age of twenty one years in equal shares And
 from and after the death of my said wife I direct my trustees to divide
 my residuary trust fund between and amongst my children in equal
 shares Provided always that if any child of mine shall die in my

lifetime leaving a child or children living at my death who being a son or sons attain the age of twentyone years or being a daughter or daughters attain that age or marry under that age then and in every such case the last mentioned child or children shall take and if more than one equally between them the share which his her or their parent would have taken of and in my residuary trust fund if such parent had survived me and attained the age of twentyone years And I declare that my trustees may postpone the sale and conversion of any part of my real or personal estate for so long as they shall think fit and that the rents profits and income to accrue after my death from such part of my estate as shall for the time being remain unsold and unconverted shall after payment thereof of all incidental expenses and outgoings and howsoever invested be paid and applied to the person or persons and in the manner to whom and in which the income of the proceeds of such sale and conversion would for the time being be payable under my Will if such sale and conversion had been actually made And I declare that all moneys liable to be invested under my Will may be invested in any stocks funds or securities for the time being authorized by law for trust moneys or in the purchase of unincorporated stock of any British Colony or on Mortgage of real property in England or Wales And I declare that the power of appointing new trustees conferred by statute shall for the purposes of this my Will be vested in my said wife during her widowhood In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand to this my Will this twenty sixth day of April one thousand nine hundred and twelve.
