This is the last Will and Testament

of me

ELIZABETH HAMBLETON SMITH of 44 Furniss Avenue Totley Rise in the City of Sheffield Spinster

1. I appoint my brother-in-law the Reverend James Sutcliffe and my nephew Kenneth Edward Sutcliffe to be Executors and Trustees of this my Will and I declare that the expression "my Trustees" hereinafter used means the Trustees or Trustee for the time being of my Will
2. I give devise and bequeath the whole of my estate and effects whether real or personal unto my Trustees Upon Trust to sell convert into money and get in the same and after paying out of the proceeds my debts and funeral and testamentary expenses to stand possessed of the residue of the proceeds of such sale conversion and getting in and the investments from time to time representing the same and and all parts of my estate for the time being unsold (all of which are included in the expression "my residuary estate" hereinafter contained) Upon the Trusts hereinafter contained.
3. I direct my Trustees to divide my residuary estate into four equal parts and to hold such equal parts upon the trusts following that is to say:-
- As to three of such equal parts Upon Trust to pay the income thereof to my sister Kate Shepherd Sutcliffe during her life and
- As to one of such equal parts Upon Trust to pay the income thereof to my sister Annie Gertrude Statham during her life And I direct that all legacy duty and other death duties (if any) payable in respect of the life interests given by this clause shall be paid out of my residuary estate.
4. I direct my Trustees (subject to the life interests of my said two sisters) to hold my residuary estate as well capital as income for such of them my nephew the said Kenneth Edward Sutcliffe my niece Margaret Louise Statham my niece Catherine Mary Hobson and

my niece Dorothy Hall Eadie as shall survive me and if more than one in equal shares.

5. I empower my Trustees to postpone for any period or periods my Trustees may think fit the sale conversion and getting in of all or any part of my estate and effects and I empower my Trustees to let lease repair insure improve and generally manage any freehold or leasehold property for the time being unsold.
6. I declare that as from my death the net income of all parts of my estate for the time being unsold shall be applied as if the same were income of investments authorised by law for the investment of trust funds and that no reversionary property or property not actually producing income shall be treated as producing income.
7. I revoke all other Wills and testamentary documents heretofore made by me
