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I, BENJAMIN ARNOLD PROWSE of 57, Ashley Road, Epsom in the County of Surrey HEREBY REVOKE all testatmentary dispositions heretofore made by me and DECLARE this to be my last Will which I make this twenty-first day of May One thousand nine hundred and thirty-six

1. I DESIRE that my body may be cremated in the simplest possible manner and that there shall be no sign of grief or mourning and no expenditure on mourning garb on account of my death which I should prefer to be regarded as an occasion for rejoicing.

2. I APPOINT Reginald F. Allum and George William Macdonald both of 35, Parliament Street in the City of Westminster (hereafter called "my Trustees") to be the Executors and Trustees of my Will and I BEQUEATH free of duty to each of them who shall prove my Will the sum of One hundred pounds.

3. I BEQUEATH to Mary Mackay of 57, Ashley Road, Epsom in the County of Surrey free of duty the sum of One Hundred Pounds and all books which at the date of my death shall be in or about my dwellinghouses known as 57, Ashley Road, Epsom aforesaid or at Strathsteven Cottage, Brora, Sutherlandshire, Scotland.

4. (1) I DEVISE AND BEQUEATH all my real and personal estate not hereby or by any codicil hereto otherwise specifically disposed of unto my Trustees Upon Trust that my Trustees shall sell the said real estate and call in sell and convert into money such part of my personal estate as does not consist of money with power to postpone such sale and conversion for such a period as my Trustees without being liable to account may think proper and so that any reversionary interest be not

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sold until it falls into possession unless my Trustees see special reason for sale.

(2) My Trustees shall out of the money to arise from the sale and conversion of the said real and personal estate and out of my ready money pay and discharge my funeral and testamentary expenses, death duties and debts and in particular I DIRECT that the debt of One Thousand Pounds due from me to Frederic Todd of The Manor House, Manchurch, Stoke on Trent in the County of Stafford if not paid during my lifetime shall be paid to him or to his personal representative as soon as conveniently may be after my decease and my Trustees shall also pay or provide for the legacies hereby or by any codicil hereto bequeathed but so that all legacies and the duty on all legacies bequeathed free of duty shall be paid primarily out of my personal estate.

5. (1) MY Trustees shall stand possessed of the residue of the said money. Upon Trust to invest the same in any investments hereby authorised with power for my Trustees at their discretion to vary such investments for others of a like nature and to retain so long as they may think fit in their existing state of investment any investments forming part of my estate at the date of my death.

(2) MY Trustees shall stand possessed of the investments hereinbefore directed to be made including any part of my residuary estate remaining unconverted and of the annual income thereof Upon Trust to pay the said income to my Wife during her life and after her death I DIRECT that the same shall be held as to both capital and income Upon Trust for such person or

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persons and if more than one in such shares and at such times and generally in such manner as my Wife shall by Will or Codicil appoint PROVIDED that notwithstanding the Trusts hereinbefore declared my Trustees shall have power in their absolute and uncontrolled discretion to apply the whole or such part as they shall think fit of my said residuary estate in the purchase of an annuity for the life of my Wife and for her absolute use and benefit.

6. MONEY liable to be invested under my Will may be invested in any investments from time to time authorised by law for the investment of Trust money or on real or leasehold securities in England or Wales or on the stocks shares or securities (not payable to bearer) of any Company incorporated under any special Act of the Imperial Parliament or on the security of any life interest in real or personal property together with an insurance on the life.
