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This is the Last Will and Testament of me
Thomas Alexander Hall of the Croxgutter Farm,
Ipstones, in the County of Stafford, I give and
bequeath all my real and personal estate of
any description unto my Trustees, namely
my dear wife Olive Hall, Walter Herbert Snow
and John Oakes Ash, and their executors,
administrators and assigns, upon trust, to
sell by auction or private contract, at such
time or times, as in their discretion they
shall deem best, ~~and~~ all my personal estate,
and from such monies and money of which I
shall be possessed at my death, pay my just
debts, funeral and testamentary expenses and
the residue of my said monies shall be
invested in the purchase of shares of the
Manchester and Liverpool District Banking Company
or of Parr's Bank, in trust for my two children
Audrey Anne Alexandra Hall and Thomas
Alexander Hall, in equal shares for their
absolute use and benefit on their attaining the
age of twentyone or twentyfive years, the fixing
of which I leave to the discretion of my Trustees,
But in the event of my said daughter dying before
the age of twentyone years then it is my wish that
her share should remain in trust for my son
Thomas Alexander, And should my son die before
he is twentyone years of age, then it is my wish
that his share shall remain in trust for my
daughter, And should both die before they are
twentyone years of age, then I declare that my
wife Olive Hall shall be possessed of the entire
residue of my personal estate. I further order
that my Trustees shall pay the whole of the
interest of the invested funds to my wife, to be
(over)

expended on the maintenance and education of my children. I give and bequeath my Cottage in Back Lane, Ipswich; to my son Thomas Alexander, on his attaining his twenty first year or his twenty fifth year, at the discretion of my trustees, the rent from the same to be paid to my wife for the maintenance and education of my children.

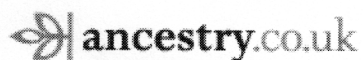
