other articles at my Dye Works at Upperhulme together with stock of Dye stuffs and all other materials also the Book Debts and any floating capital in the proportion of two thirds to my son William Alexander Tatton and one third to my daughter Helen Kirk Locker In the new company to be formed my son is to receive a salary of Six hundred pounds a year so long as he is capable of efficiently fulfilling the duties of the chief manager of the business And in like manner a succeeding chief manager who will also be the chairman of the company shall receive a salary not exceeding Six hundred pounds a year

In thus surrendering my interests and income from my real estate and the Dye Works I am to receive an income of Four hundred pounds a year so long as I shall live and this shall be the first charge on my estate.
