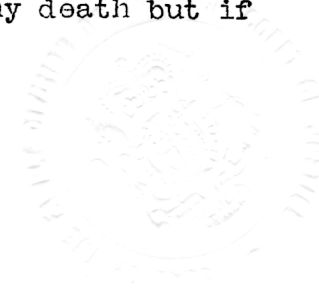

I APPOINT my son DOUGLAS MONTGOMERY BERNARD HALL THOMAS SUTTON TIMMIS of 88 St. James' Street London and SIR WILLIAM JOYNSON HICKS Baronet of 15 St. James' Place London to be *Executors* of this my Will and I APPOINT my wife DAME CAROLINE MONTGOMERY HALL and the said three Executors *Trustees* of this my Will and Trustees for the purposes of the Settled Land Acts but I make such special appointment of literary executors as is hereinafter contained.

2.

I DIRECT that all typewritten and handwritten papers and documents and ledgers in my possession at the date of my death (but excluding any in the hands of my Solicitors Field Roscoe & Company or of my Bankers the London County Westminster and Parr's Bank of 21 Lombard Street London and Cox & Company of 16 Charing Cross London and my locked green investment book) shall be gone through and inspected by the said Thomas Sutton Timmis if he shall be in Great Britain at the time of my death or within three months afterwards and by my Secretary Daisy Gladys Shirley if she shall be in my employment at the time of my death but if

the said Thomas Sutton Timmis does not inform my said Solicitors within such period of three months of his then address in Great Britain and of his willingness to act in this matter or if he declines to act or if the said Daisy Gladys Shirley shall not be in my employment as aforesaid then I appoint in place of him or her or them respectively the following person or persons as the case may be and in the following order namely :-

(a) Thomas F. Dawkins of 11 Park Lane, London.

(b) Wellwood James Maxwell of 56 Moorgate Street
London Chartered Accountant and

(c) Frederic William Emery a member of the said
Firm of Field Roscoe & Company, Solicitors

so that there shall not be more than two persons acting in this matter and the persons so acting shall on the conclusion of their work receive each the sum of Two hundred pounds free of all duties and such persons or person so acting are hereinafter referred to as my literary executors.

3. I DIRECT that as soon as my literary executors find any document which in their opinion is of importance in connection with the administration of my estate they shall at once communicate its contents to my said wife and son and shall if my wife and son shall so direct hand over such document to my executors and save as aforesaid they shall personally burn all my papers.

4. I BEQUEATH the following pecuniary legacy free of all duties namely To my grand-daughter Pamela Mary Hall if my son shall not survive me but not otherwise the sum of One thousand pounds. If she is not of legal age at the date of my death I DIRECT that the said sum shall be paid to my wife on her behalf and my wife's receipt shall be a sufficient discharge to my Executors.
5. I BEQUEATH to my Mother-in-Law Mrs. Harriet Montgomery 74 bis rue de Ranelagh Paris if my wife does not survive me but not otherwise an annuity of Five hundred pounds per annum for her life free of all duties and I direct my Executors to purchase out of my estate from any Life Insurance Company they may choose an annuity for that amount to commence as from the date of my death.
6. I DEVISE all my real estate and I BEQUEATH all the residue of my personal estate after payment of my debts funeral and testamentary expenses legacies and annuities and all duties payable thereon together Hereinafter called my residuary estate Unto and to the use of my Trustees in fee simple or absolutely as the case may be.
7. I DIRECT that my Trustees shall divide my residuary estate into four equal parts and shall pay and transfer one of such parts to my said son Douglas Montgomery Bernard Hall absolutely and shall pay and transfer two other of such parts

to my said wife absolutely and I direct that my Trustees shall retain the remaining one of such parts hereinafter called "the settled share" upon the trusts hereinafter declared concerning the same.

8. My Trustees shall hold the settled share of my residuary estate of whatsoever the same shall consist in manner following namely to pay and transfer the same to my son if any son shall have been born to him who would be heir to my Baronetcy but if no such heir shall have been born to my son in my lifetime then from time to time to invest and accumulate the income of the settled share until such heir shall be born to my son and if and when such heir is born to my son to pay and transfer the settled share and all accumulations thereof to my son but if no such heir shall be born to him during the period allowed by law for the accumulation of income then at the end of such period to hold the settled share and all accumulations thereof for such of them my said grand-daughter Pamela Mary Hall and any other daughters born to my said son before the end of such period as shall attain the age of twenty one years in equal shares absolutely and if no grand-daughter of mine shall attain the age of twenty one years the settled share and the accumulations thereof shall be divided equally between my

wife and my son.

9. I DECLARE that my wife shall take as part of her absolute share of my residuary estate whichever she may choose of my two residences namely 10 Cadogan Gardens aforesaid and Castle Priory Wallingford in the County of Berks with all the land and trees appertaining to it in Oxfordshire amounting altogether to about thirty three acres and the other of such residences shall be taken by my son as part of his absolute share of my residuary estate and in working out the division of my estate my Trustees shall treat the values of the said residences respectively as being the amounts for which I have recently purchased the same. Subject as aforesaid my Trustees may fix the value of any real or personal estate for the purpose of division or appropriation in such manner as they shall think fit and I DECLARE that every valuation appropriation and partition made by my Trustees shall be binding upon all persons interested under this my Will.

10. I DIRECT that my wife shall have in addition to any other provisions I have made for her by this my Will the right to select and retain as her own property any of the furniture and indoor and outdoor effects in or about the said houses 10 Cadogan Gardens and Castle Priory and to remove them to or exchange them for articles in the house

which she selects under this my Will as hereinbefore provided but so that she shall leave the house not selected by her well furnished and all the contents of the house not selected by her which she shall leave there or remove there are to belong to my son absolutely and the gifts of furniture and effects provided for in this clause are to be taken as independent bequests free of all duties and not as parts of my wife's and my son's respective shares of my Residuary Estate.

11. I put on record that in making this Will I have had regard to the trusts of the Will of my father and of other family dispositions under which my son will largely benefit on my death.
