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THIS IS THE LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT of me JOHN HOWE HALL
of Larks Lees Boldre Lymington in the County of Hants
Retired Silk Manufacturer

1. I Revoke all former Wills and Codicils made by me
2. I Appoint District Bank Limited (hereinafter separately called the Bank) whose registered office is at Spring Gardens Manchester and Edward Oliver Jones of Leek in the County of Stafford Solicitor (the Bank and the said Edward Oliver Jones being hereinafter together called my Trustees) to be the Executors and Trustees of this my Will and to be Trustees of the settlement made by this my Will for the purposes of the Settled Land Act
3. I Give to the Bank the following powers:-
 - (a) Power to make such charges for services to my estate as are usually made by the Bank for services to the Banks ordinary customers and to keep for the purposes of my estate one or more account or accounts with power in particular to make advances to my estate in any such account on the usual terms and to employ any credit balance in the general business of the Bank without liability to account for profits thereby arising
 - (b) Power to obtain on the usual terms as to remuneration any professional assistance which the Bank may consider expedient but I desire the Bank unless there is good reason to the contrary to employ the Solicitors usually employed by me
 - (c) Power out of my estate to retain its fees for acting as executor and/or Trustee hereof such fees to be free of legacy or other duty and to be charged to capital or income as the Bank may think right
4. In case the Bank (in this clause called the District Bank) shall go into liquidation I authorise the District Bank or its liquidator or liquidators to appoint as sole Trustee

in the District Bank's place any other bank of good standing and the Bank so appointed shall have all the powers and authorities (including this present power) hereby conferred on the District Bank

5. The Bank shall have the exclusive custody of all the trust funds investments properties securities and documents and its name shall be placed first on all company and other registers and documents of title and it shall be exclusively entitled to receive all income and to exercise all voting and other rights
6. I Direct that notwithstanding his acceptance of the Executorship or Trusteeship hereof or any of the trusts thereof the said Edward Oliver Jones shall be allowed all professional charges for his time and trouble which if employed as Solicitor to my Executors or Trustees not himself being an Executor or Trustee he would be entitled to make
7. I Bequeath to the said Edward Oliver Jones a legacy of Fifty pounds free of duty if he shall prove my Will and act in the trusts thereof
8. I Devise and Bequeath all my real and the residue of my personal estate including all entailed property of which I have power to dispose by Will unto my Trustees upon trust (subject to the provisions of this my Will) to sell call in and convert the same into money and after payment thereof of my debts and funeral and testamentary expenses to invest the residue of such monies in their names in any investments authorised by law or by this my Will or any Codicil thereto and to stand possessed of such investments and of all parts of the residue of my estate for the time being unsold (hereinafter called my residuary estate) upon the trusts hereinafter declared concerning the same
9. My Trustees shall stand possessed of any residuary estate upon the following trusts that is to say:-

(i) Upon trust to pay to my Wife Irene Hall one half of

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the income thereof during her life so long as she shall remain my Widow and from and upon her re-marriage to pay to her one third of the income thereof during the remainder of her life

- (ii) Upon trust to pay the other half of the income thereof or in the case of and as from the re-marriage of my said Wife the other two thirds of the income thereof to my son Peter John Howe Hall but so nevertheless that my said son shall receive his share of the said income only as from the date he attains the age of twenty one years and until he attains the age of twenty five years and that his share of income while under the age of twenty one years shall be paid to and received by my said wife for her sole use and benefit except that my said wife shall maintain a home for my said son if he desires to reside with her and shall properly maintain educate bring up and provide all necessities for my said son in a manner suitable to his station in life until he shall attain the age of twenty one years
- (iii) Upon trust after my said son shall attain the age of twenty five years as to both the capital and income of the said one half of my residuary estate or in the case of the remarriage of my said wife the said two thirds of my residuary estate for my said son absolutely
- (iv) Upon trust after the death of my said wife as to both the capital and income of the remainder of my residuary estate for my said son absolutely
- (v) Provided nevertheless that in case my said son shall die before attaining the age of twenty five years leaving a child or children who shall attain the age of twenty one years or marry under that age such child or children shall take by substitution and if more than one in equal shares the share of my residuary

estate which my said son would have taken if he had survived me and attained a vested interest

- (vi) If neither my said son nor any child of my said son shall attain a vested interest in my residuary estate under the preceding trusts then my trustees shall hold my residuary estate (subject to the trusts powers and provisions hereby or by statute vested in my Trustees in respect of the income or the capital thereof and to every exercise of the same by my Trustees) Upon Trust to pay the whole of the income thereof to my said wife so long as she shall remain my Widow and from and after her remarriage to pay to her one third of the income of my residuary estate for her life and subject thereto upon trust as to one third of the capital and income of my residuary estate for the Congleton (Cheshire) Branch of the National Children's Home and upon trust as to the capital and income of the remaining two thirds of my residuary estate for such of my nephews John Lennox Kincaid Hall and Patrick Hall and my nieces Marianne Stenson Margaret Hall Joan Dodd and Pamela Bridge as shall survive me and if more than one in equal shares as tenants in common Provided always that in case any of my said nephew or nieces shall die in my lifetime leaving a child or children living at my death who shall attain the age of twenty one years or marry under that age such last mentioned child or children shall stand in the place of his her or their deceased parent and take per stirpes and equally between them if more than one the share of my residuary estate which his her or their parent would have taken if he or she had survived me and attained a vested interest And I Declare that the receipt or acknowledgement of the Treasurer for the time being of the said Congleton (Cheshire) Branch of the National Children's Home to my Trustees shall be a sufficient discharge to them for any payment or transfer of any part of my residuary estate to the

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said institution

10. I Declare that my Trustees may postpone the sale calling in and conversion of any part of my real or personal estate for such period as they may in their absolute discretion deem fit without being liable to account notwithstanding that it may be of a wasting speculative or reversionary nature and that pending such sale calling in and conversion the income (including the net rents and profits of real estate and chattels real after payment of rates taxes rent costs of insurance repairs and other outgoings properly attributable in the opinion of my Trustees to income) of property actually producing income shall be applied as from my death as income and on the other hand on such sale calling in and conversion or on the falling in of any reversionary property no part of the proceeds of such sale calling in or conversion or of such property shall be paid or applied as past income And in particular I Declare that notwithstanding anything contained in this my Will no sale shall be made of the house in which I now reside with the land and premises thereto known as Larks Lees aforesaid or of my household furniture and indoor and outdoor effects including motor cars and other articles of household or domestic use or ornament in use by me at my death in connection with my said residence land and premises during the widowhood of my said wife without her consent in writing and that until the sale thereof and during the widowhood of my said wife my Trustees shall permit my said wife to occupy and use the same so long as she shall desire she keeping the said residence land and premises and the said furniture and effects in good repair and condition and insured against fire to the full value thereof at her own cost in the names of my Trustees and that it shall not be necessary for my Trustees to have any inventory taken of the said furniture and effects or to see to the repair

or insurance of the said furniture and effects and that they shall not be personally liable by reason of the neglect or omission of my wife to repair or insure such furniture and effects or by reason of any loss resulting therefrom or from their being in the possession of and used by my said wife but that nevertheless my trustees may take such steps as they think fit for the protection and preservation of the said furniture and effects

11. I Empower my Trustees in relation to any stocks shares and securities in Brough Nicholson and Hall Limited which may be at any time subject to the trusts of this my Will or any Codicil thereto to agree to or concur in any amalgamation reconstruction or re-arrangement or sale of the said Company's business which might affect the said stocks shares and securities

12. I Direct that any moneys liable to be invested by my Trustees may be invested in their names in as well any investments for the time being allowed by law for the investment of trust funds as debentures stocks shares or securities of every description in Brough Nicholson and Hall Limited and in any company which upon any reconstruction amalgamation or sale shall take over the business of the said Company and shares of or money on deposit with the Leek United and Midlands Building Society and the Leek and Moorlands Building Society and in or upon any other stocks shares funds or securities in which any part of my estate may be invested at the time of my death and in and upon any shares stocks or securities of any company or corporation whether commercial municipal local or otherwise carrying on business or constituted for any purpose in the United Kingdom or India or any Colony or Dependency of the United Kingdom with liberty to vary and transfer the same from time to time and accordingly all such stocks

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shares and securities shall be authorised investments
under this my Will or any Codicil thereto

13. I Declare that no part of any dividends rents interests
royalties or moneys of the nature of income which shall be
actually paid after the date of my death shall be apportion-
ed to or treated as capital of my estate and I Declare
that the whole thereof (whether the same be paid in respect
of a period wholly or only partly prior to my death) shall
belong to the person entitled under my Will or any Codicil
thereto to the investment or property from which the
same respectively arose and if there shall be a tenant
for life of such investment or property such dividend
rent interest royalty or money shall be income payable
to or for the benefit of such tenant for life

14. I negative the rules known as the rules in Howe v Earl
Dartmouth and Allhusen v Whittell in all their branches

1. I DECLARE that my said Will shall be read and shall take effect as if clause 9(v) thereof had read as follows, namely, Provided nevertheless that in case my said son shall die in my lifetime or before attaining the age of Twenty-five years leaving a child or children who shall attain the age of Twenty one years or marry under that age such child or children shall take by substitution and if more than one in equal shares the share of my residuary estate which my said son would have taken if he had survived me and attained a vested interest.

3. I DIRECT that no beneficiary taking any share or interests under the trusts of this my Will or any Codicil thereto shall (except where otherwise expressly stated or provided) be liable to bring into account any sum of money or value of any property or interest which I have already paid

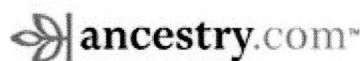
