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THIS IS THE LAST WILL of me JOHN HALL of Ball Haye^{Hall} Leek in the County of Stafford Esquire I hereby revoke all former wills made by me I appoint my sons John Howe Hall George Hambleton Hall Bernard Rault Hall and Clement Thomas Gwynne Solicitor Leek EXECUTORS of this my will and I give to the last named Clement Thomas Gwynne the sum of One hundred pounds as an acknowledgment for his trouble I bequeath the following legacies and direct that the same be paid free of estate and legacy duty at the end of twelve calendar months from my death unless my Executors shall think fit sooner to pay then namely to my Brother Ralph Critchlow Hall now residing at Oulton Cross Farm Stone the money I have lent him as a loan amounting to about Two hundred pounds and in addition Three hundred pounds but this is to be paid

to him by instalments as needed at the discretion of my Executors and such part as may not be required to be paid by instalments to be invested and the income accumulated so as to be some provision for old age To my Brother Robert Hall now residing at Plymouth the sum of five hundred pounds to my Brother James Hall now residing in London the sum of Three hundred pounds and to my sister Mrs Wilkin now residing at Wellington Somerset the sum of five hundred pounds I bequeath to my Trustees four thousand five hundred pounds or if at the date of my decease the business of Brough Nicholson and Hall shall be converted into a Limited Company that amount of Debentures in such Company Upon trust in their discretion and of their uncontrolled authority to pay and apply the whole or such portion only of the income of the said four thousand five hundred pounds or said debentures as they shall think expedient to or for the clothing board lodging maintenance and support or otherwise for the personal and peculiar benefit of my daughter Agnes Hall during her life at such time or times in such portions and in such manner in all respects as my said Trustees shall think most conducive to her comfort and convenience It is my earnest wish (but I do not impose it as a condition) that she should not marry But should she marry then at her death I give and devise the said four thousand five hundred pounds or debentures to my Trustees Upon trust for such child or children of my said daughter Agnes as shall live to attain the age of twenty one years or being a daughter or daughters shall marry under that age and on the death of my said daughter Agnes without leaving such child or children then I give the said four thousand five hundred pounds or debenture stock to my Trustees Upon trust for my other children who shall then be living in equal shares and the issue of any deceased child such issue taking their deceased parents share equally I bequeath to my son Harold Alexander Hall the sum of Ten thousand pounds which he at present holds as a loan from me and also such further sum of money or its equivalent in property as will make his share under this my will of equal value to what I have left to each of my other three sons including the shares left to them in the business of Brough Nicholson & Hall the value of such shares being computed at One hundred pounds for every five pounds of annual dividend or income derived from such shares averaged on the year ending on thirty first December preceding my decease and the two preceding years I give my household furniture plate linen pictures inside and outside chattels and effects also my horses and carriages to my unmarried children for so long as not less than two of my children may desire to keep Ball Haye Hall as a residence and whenever my unmarried children decide to give up Ball Haye Hall or when there may be only one child desiring to do so then I direct the said furniture chattels and effects horses and carriages to be divided among all my children (including my daughter Agnes) or sold as my Trustees may decide The residue of my real and personal estate excepting that which forms my

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partnership interest in the Firm of Brough Nicholson & Hall and after the payment of my just debts and funeral expenses I bequeath to my children Elsie Mary Hall John Howe Hall Jeannette Allen George Hambleton Hall Kate Hall and Bernard Rault Hall in equal shares the method of dividing such property whether by sale and division of the proceeds or by a partition or by some method agreeable to the majority of the Beneficiaries I leave to the discretion of my Trustees I bequeath my interest in the business of Brough Nicholson & Hall and now carried on by me in partnership with Arthur Nicholson to my Executors Upon trust to continue and carry on the same until the said business is converted into a Limited Liability Company and I direct my share in the said business whether the same shall consist of my share of capital in the said business or whether the same shall consist of shares in the said business after conversion into a Limited Company to be divided into fifteen equal portions after such necessary portion has been appropriated to my son Harold Alexander as will make his interest under this my will equal to that of each of my other three sons and three such equal portions shall belong to each of my sons John Howe Hall George Hambleton Hall and Bernard Rault Hall and two such equal portions shall be held by my Trustees for fifteen years Upon trust for each of my three daughters Elsie Mary Hall Jeanette Allen and Kate Hall and at the expiration of such term of Fifteen years I give the said two equal portions to each of my last named three daughters absolutely and I desire the shares in the said business to be so divided that my sons may have a larger proportion of ordinary preference shares and my daughters a larger proportion of debenture stock Upon failure of my sons and daughters agreeing as to the division of the shares according to the different kinds of shares my Trustees shall make a division or allocation and the same shall be binding and conclusive I request my sons (but I do not impose it upon them as a trust) not to dispose of any portion of these shares for a period of fifteen years excepting to one or others of their Brothers and sisters whom also I request not to dispose of any portion of them till fifteen years have elapsed since my death and after the lapse of this period I desire but do not require that if they wish to sell their shares or any portion of them they should in the first instance offer them to one or other of their Brothers and sisters and failing to sell to them it is my wish that they should offer them to one or other shareholders in the said Company of Brough Nicholson & Hall subject to the articles of Association of the said Company I empower my Trustees to do every act and thing which may be necessary to convert the said business into a Limited Company and to take the purchase money of such business in cash or in shares or partly in cash and partly in shares and to invest any part of my estate in shares or debentures of the said Company and to pay the share of the cost of the formation and registration of such Company and any expenses which may be incidental thereto Notwithstanding the previous gifts in

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favour of my daughters Elsie Mary Hall Kate Hall and Jeannette Allen I direct my Trustees to set aside and retain out of the shares of my property hereinbefore given to or directed to be held in trust for them three separate sums of six thousand pounds or investments or securities to that value as my Trustees may select (one of each of such separate sums being set aside out of each of my said three daughters shares under this my will) and each of the said sums of six thousand pounds shall be retained by my Trustees and held by them Upon trust to pay the annual income thereof to my daughter entitled thereto for her separate use during her life without power of alienation or anticipation and immediately after the death of my same daughter as well as to capital of the said six thousand pounds hereinafter called the said settled fund as the income In trust for all or any of the children and remoter issue of my same daughter (such remoter issue being born in her lifetime) in such proportions and for such interests to be absolutely vested within twenty one years from her death as she whether covert or discoverd shall from time to time by Deed with or without power of revocation and new appointment or by her will appoint But no child in whose favour or in favour of whose issue an appointment shall be made shall participate under the trust next hereinafter contained in the unappointed portion of the settled fund without bringing the benefit of such appointment into hotchpot and in default of appointment or subject to any partial appointment In trust for the children of my same daughter who shall being sons attain the age of twenty one years or being daughters attain that age or be married under that age such children if more than one to take in equal shares and if there shall not be any child of my same daughter who being a son shall attain the said age or being a daughter shall attain such age or marry In trust for such persons for such interests and generally in such manner as my same daughter shall by will appoint and in default thereof In trust for the persons who at the death of my same daughter shall be of kin to her and who under the Statutes for the distribution of intestates effects would be entitled to her personal estate if she were dead a Spinster and intestate such persons to take in the proportions prescribed by the same Statutes I empower my Trustees at their discretion to continue all or any part of my personal estate in the state or upon the investments in or upon which the same shall be at the time of my death however doubtful or hazardous or limited the description or nature of the property or investment may be I declare that the expression "my Trustees" hereinbefore used includes my Executors hereinbefore appointed and any other person and persons who may for the time being be the Trustees of my will

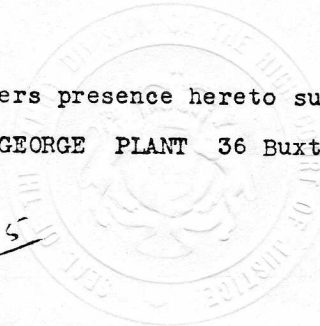

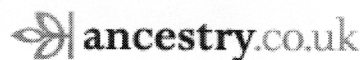
