

HALL—Friday, October 1, 1982, Mr. Norman A. Hall, late of Pioneer Village Nursing Home, Regina, passed away in his 96th year. Predeceased by his wife, Gertrude, 1974; sister, Dorothy and brother, Aubrey, Mr. Hall is survived by three daughters: Mrs. E.J. Fisher (Beatrice), Lloydminster, Alta., Mrs. W.E.
