

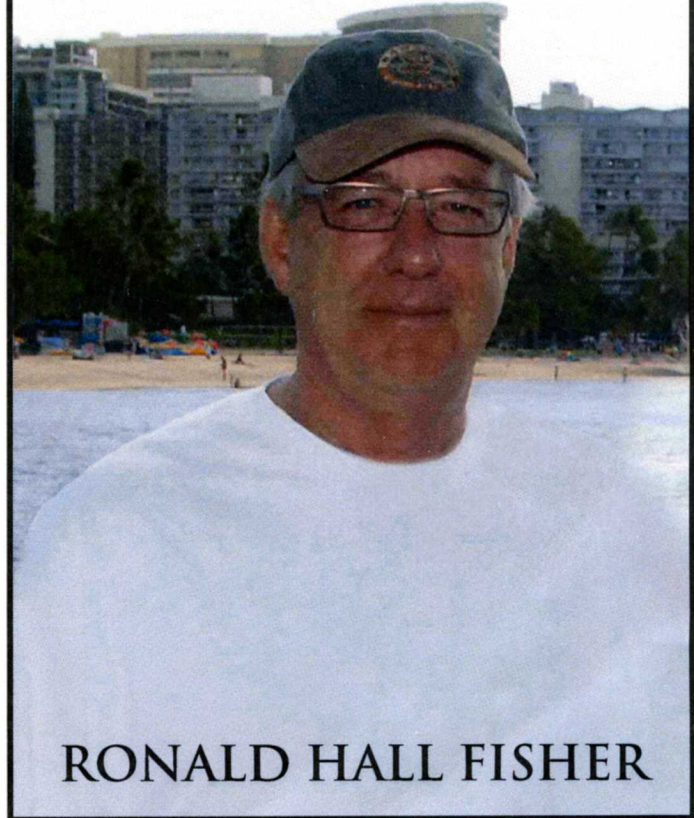
FISHER ~ Ronald
