Hi Brian

Thank you for replying to my email, my interest in MBH is that she was a locally born girl, an Artist, and lies buried with her two sisters and step-brother in a vault in our churchyard which is All Saints Church, Childwall. We have a Stained Glass Window dedicated to her (Emmaus Window by Mary Lowndes) which was installed by a faculty from Henrietta Louise Greenfield, also there is a Brass Plaque commemorating her and as people know of her painting of 'Fantine' then they come to our church to try and find out more about her. I spend my time carrying out research on famous people buried in our churchyard and MBH is one.

There is also another interest in her sister Florence, who at the age of 22 years went to visit Margaret whilst she was studying in Paris. It was there that Florence caught the plague and died.

Bernard was devastated at the death of his young daughter so he built the first Boys Youth Club in the country, in the Dingle area of Liverpool and called it the Florence Institute. It lay derelict for years but local support had over 3-million pounds spent on bring it back to its former glory as a youth club and it is going strong today. It is known locally as the "Florrie" and I went there as a lad in the 40's so there is another interest in the Hall Family. I also do Maritime History and am interested in Bernard's background trading with the West Indies, there was a Sailing Ship called the "Bernard Hall" which was wrecked.

To find out about the other paintings of Margaret then I believe the H.L.Greenfield disposed of them and they hang in private collections

I would like to ask you if any Photographs, sketches exist of the family? and also where Bernard's first wife, Mary Ann lies buried?

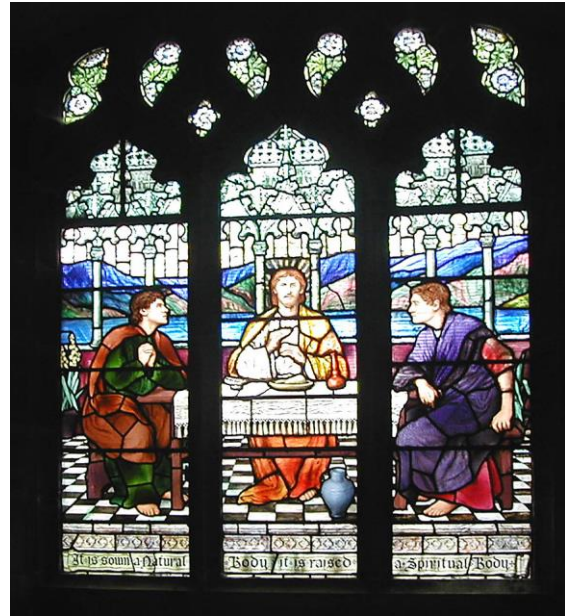
