Dudlow House was the home of Bernard Hall^A and his family from c1862 to after 1872. In 1871 the household consisted of Bernard, his wife Margaret^B and their children Bernard Vincent^C, Alexander Titley^D, Percy Bernard^E, Margaret Berardine^F, Florence Bernadine^G, Douglas Bernard^H, and Evelyne Bernard^I. The children ranged in age from 7 months to 22 Years. Another child, Muriel Bernard^J was born the following year. There were also five servants - cook, housemaid, waitress and two nurses.

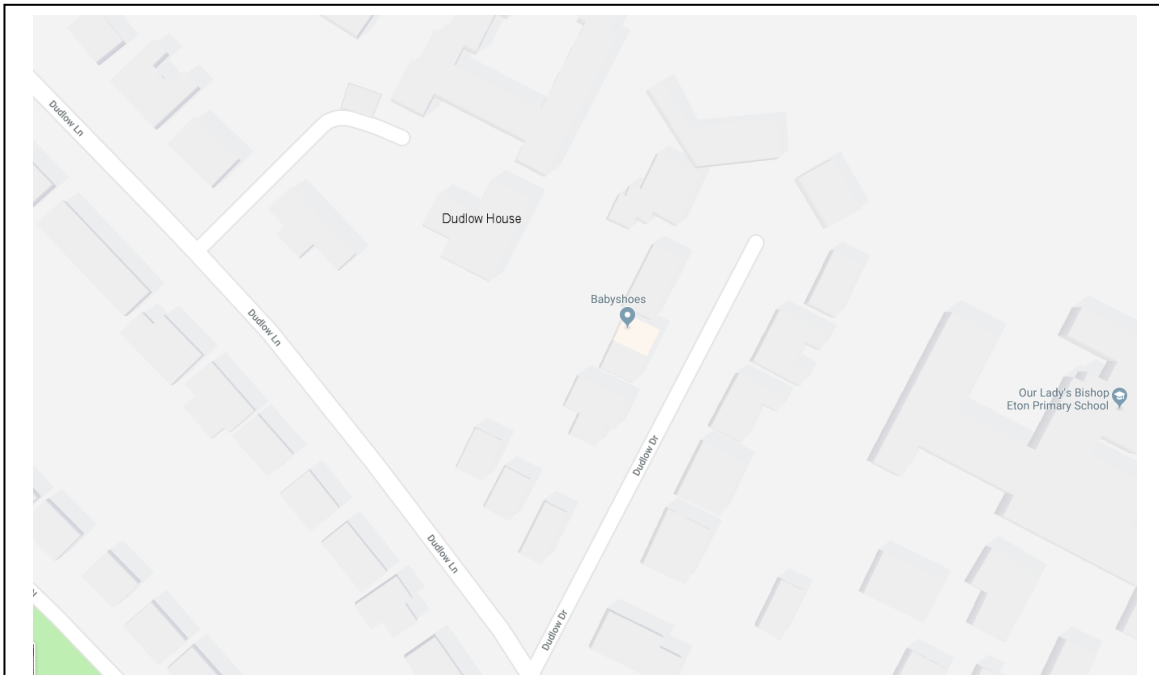

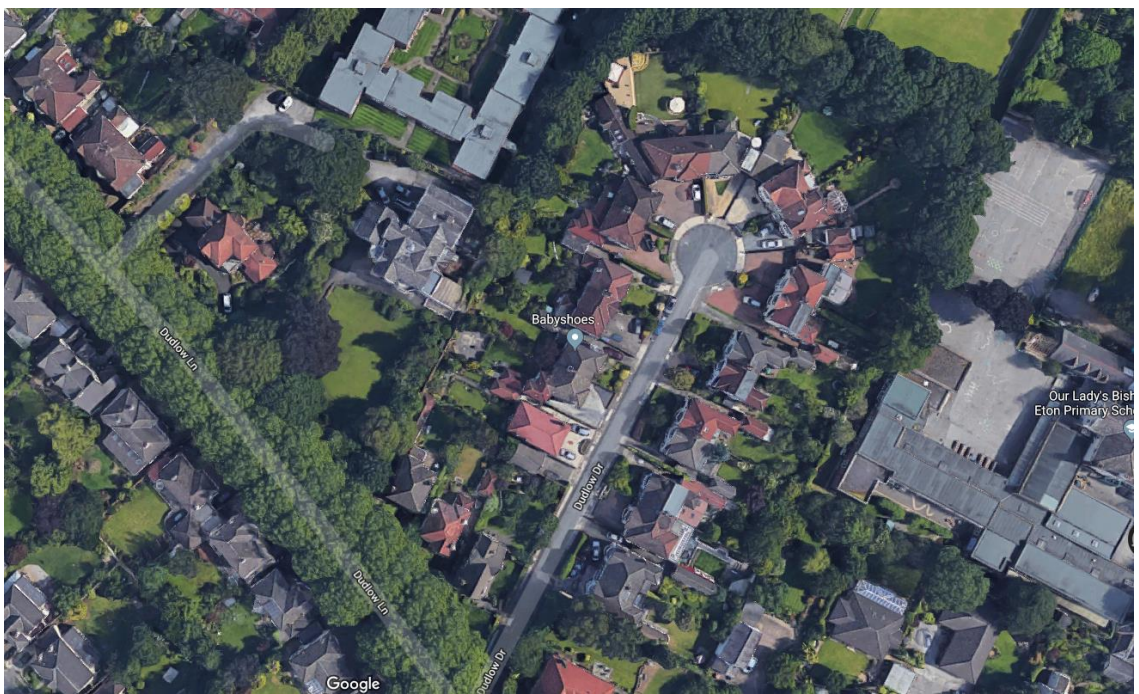
