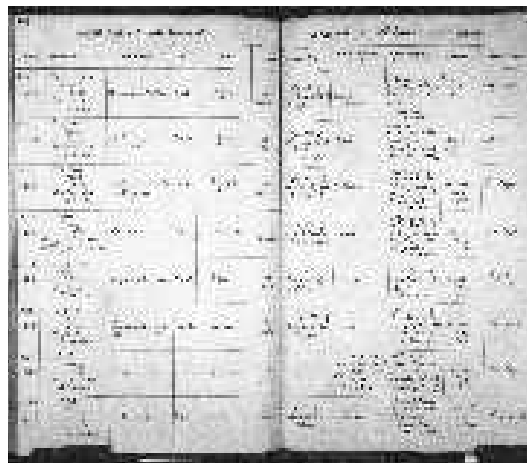

BIRTHS AND DEATHS REGISTRATION LAW, 1877.

MEDICAL CERTIFICATE OF THE CAUSE OF DEATH.

To be given by the Medical Attendant to the Person whose death it is to give it, with Information of the Death, to the Registrar of the District to which the Death took place, and TO NO OTHER PERSON

I HEREBY CERTIFY that I attended Agnesa Tilly
 whose age was stated to be 66 ; that I last saw her on the 5 day of
May 1883 ; that she Died * on the 6 day of
May 1883 at Halfway Tree ; and that to the
 best of my knowledge and belief the Cause of her Death was as hereunder written.

* Should the Medical Attendant not feel prepared to taking upon himself the responsibility of certifying the part of Death, he may here insert the words "as I am informed."

* The duration of a well formed Disease of Symptom, is reckoned from its commencement until Death occurs.
