Dear Brian,

Thanks a lot for your letter of 18th July with your typewritten copies of "the book" and the 1913 notes by Douglas (*Douglas Bernard Hall 285*) - you have been busy! I'm sorry to be so late replying but I think the post takes about 8 days so this should reach you well before the 18th which Peter tells me is when you plan to set off for England! I am very much looking forward to meeting you and your father on the 23rd!

Dealing with the points you raise very briefly, I have found some odd errors and will let you know when we meet. I photocopied the original "book" - my copperplate handwriting is non-existent! The "book" appears to contain a full record of the researcher's information - I have no more. I very much like your tree beginning with John Hall (*222*) and Ann Titley (*223*) but I've not yet really got down to studying the individual "person sheets" which you sent with it.

What I have managed to do is re-write my 1966 reconstruction of the lost "Spring Roller" and I now enclose two photocopies of it (on a few sheets side by side) and I have added to it Mary (*224*), Elizabeth (*225*), and John (*226*), (sister and brother of Thomas Alexander Hall (1807-87) (*175*) who appear on your tree although I have no previous record of them here!

Thanks very much for the census info. and the various birth and marriage certs. I'm afraid I have little or no other certificates.

I think I was given Margaret's (*not sure who she is*) name (gr. grandfather's younger sister) by Jean Wooliscroft Tatton (*197*) about 15 or 16 years ago. She is the youngest grandchild of Elizabeth Hall (*166*) and William Tatton (*268*). She was born on 12/12/1912 and fortunately is

still very much alive and now living (since last summer) in a "residential home" called Wetley Manor, Wetley Rocks, Stoke-on-Trent, only about 5 miles away, so I will have to ask her more about Margaret and I'm sure she would very much like to see you while you are here. She seems to have a good memory! I'm afraid that this has to be all for now.
