This is the last Will of me Edward Hall of Longton
in the County of Stafford Grocer - First I direct my just debts funeral
and testamentary expences to be paid as soon as conveniently may be
after my decease - And subject thereto and charged with the payment thereof
I give devise and bequeath unto my Trustees after named All and singular
my real and personal estates and effects of what nature or kind soever
and wheresoever the same may be situate Upon the Trusts and for the
intents and purposes hereinafter declared concerning the same respectively;
That is to say, Upon Trust immediately after my decease to take an
Inventory and Account of my Household Goods Ship Fixtures and Utensils
Stock in Trade Book Debts and ready money And Upon Trust to permit
my dear wife Joanna to use and enjoy the same and therewith to carry
on my said business for her own benefit and the maintenance education
and benefit of my children during their minority until all the children
I now have or may hereafter have by her shall have attained the age
of Twenty one years or have departed this life under the said age -
And as to my Messuage in which I live and carry on my said business
Upon Trust during the time aforesaid to permit my said wife to occupy
the same and carry on my said business therein And Upon Trust to
let set and manage the residue of my said real estate and receive the
rents and profits thereof and apply the same, after paying all costs
charges and expences for repairing, insuring against loss by fire, and
managing the same premises, in payment of so much of my debts -
funeral and testamentary expences as the residue of my personal estate
shall be insufficient to pay, and in making the contributions payable
for subscriptions redemption money premiums fines or otherwise in respect
of the shares and share of which I am the holder in any Benefit -
Building Society And in the next place if needful and so far as my
Trustees or Trustee may consider necessary in maintaining educating
and bringing up my said children And Upon Trust as to the residue
for and to be equally divided amongst all my said children who shall
attain the age of twenty one years to be paid as soon as all my said
children shall have attained the said age or died thereunder And Upon
Trust as to all my Messuages lands tenements and hereditaments so soon
as all my said children shall have attained the said age of twenty one
years or died thereunder to sell and dispose the same either by Public
Auction or Private Contract and either in one lot or several lots and
subject to such conditions as they he or she may think expedient and for
that purpose to enter into and make all necessary contracts and assurances
of the same or of any part thereof And I declare that their his or her
receipts for purchase monies shall be good discharges to purchasers, who
shall not be required to see to the application of the monies therein expressed

to be received, nor be answerable for the loss, misapplication or nonapplication thereof or of any part thereof nor shall such purchasers be required to enquire into the propriety or expediency of any such sale And Upon Trust by and out of the said Trust monies and premises to lay out and invest a sum sufficient to raise an Annuity of Twenty Pounds for my said Wife, which I hereby give to her, to be payable from and after all my said children shall have attained the said age of twenty one years or died thereunder during the term of her natural life to be made by half yearly payments the first payment to be made in six calendar months after the happening of the event aforesaid on the happening of which she becomes entitled to the Annuity Provided nevertheless that if she shall marry again the said Annuity shall thenceforth be reduced to an Annuity of Ten Pounds per year payable as aforesaid And Upon Trust on the happening of the event aforesaid to sell and dispose of the household goods Shop Fixtures and Utensils and Stock in trade then existing out of or by means of my estate, & after paying to my said wife any surplus there may be beyond the amount of the Inventory and Account herebefore directed to be taken, to divide the proceeds arising from the said sale into and equally amongst my said wife and children And upon Trust out of the residue of the said trust monies and premises to pay to my Son William and to any other Son I may have by my said wife the sum of Fifty Pounds each And Upon Trust to divide and pay the remainder into and equally amongst all the children I have or may have by my said wife equally share and share alike and their executors administrators and assigns as tenants in common And I declare that the interests herein given to my children shall be considered as vested in them respectively on their respectively attaining the age of twenty one years, though the same respectively may be to be enjoyed or become payable at any other time herein mentioned And I declare that if any of my said children shall die under the said age leaving ^{issue} lawful ^{issue} him or her surviving such issue shall take the share whether original, or accruing by the decease of any other child, and whether of principal, or accumulations of rents or interest, which his or her or their deceased Parent would have taken had he or she attained the said age And I declare that if any of my children shall die under the said age without leaving lawful issue him or her surviving the share of him or her so dying whether original, or accruing as aforesaid, and whether of principal, or accumulations as aforesaid, shall go to the survivors or survivor of others or other of my children and their his or her ^{issue} executors administrators or assigns as part of the share hereby given or accruing to them him or her And I hereby declare that it shall be lawful for the trustees or Trustee acting in execution of the trusts hereof to advance to any of my children or their lawful issue without interest payable therefor portions of the said Trust monies and premises whether of principal, or of accumulations of rents or

be presumptively entitled in part payment by anticipation of his her or their
share or shares And I do hereby direct that in case my Trustees hereby
appointed or to be appointed as hereinafter mentioned or any of them shall
die or desire to be discharged from or decline or become incapable to act in the
execution of the trusts of this my will it shall be lawful for the surviving
13 or continuing Trustees or Trustee for the time being under this my will or
the executors or administrators of the last surviving or continuing Trustee
for the time being by any Deed or Deeds from time to time to appoint
any new Trustees or Trustee in the place of the Trustees or Trustee so dying
14 or desiring to be discharged ^{declining or} becoming incapable to act as aforesaid And
I do hereupon the said Trust estates and effects shall be conveyed assigned and
transferred in such manner that the same may be vested in such new
Trustees or Trustee either alone or jointly with the surviving or continuing Trustee
or Trustee for the time being upon the subsisting Trusts hereof And that every
such new Trustee shall act in execution of the same Trusts and have and
be invested with the same powers discretions and authorities as if he had
been originally appointed a Trustee by this my Will instead of the Trustee
hereby appointed to whom he shall succeed And I do hereby authorize and
empower my Trustees or Trustee to deduct and retain to or for themselves
15 himself or herself and allow each other all costs charges and expences
incurred or sustained in any manner relating to my estates or the trusts
and powers hereby reposed in them him or her And I declare that one
shall not be accountable for another nor for the acts deeds or defaults of
another but each for himself and herself and his or her own acts deeds
or defaults And that they shall not be answerable for losses occasioned
by any Agent Banker or other person employed by them or any of them
16 respecting my estates nor for losses thereto unless the same be occasioned
by wilful neglect or default And I appoint my said wife and
my Brothers John and Thomas Alexander Executors and Trustees of this
my Will and Testamentary Guardians of my said children And hereby
revoking all former Wills declare this only to be my last In Witness
whereof I have to this and the two other sheets thereof set my hand this
fourteenth day of March one thousand eight hundred and fifty four.
