The following abstract is from Document H76, Pedigree of "Hall" on Spring Roller.

Thomas Hall (651) of Spott in the parish of Stone in the county of Stafford yeoman. Will dated 22 November 1636. To be buried in the parish Church of Stone.

To **Joane (671)** the wife of **Henry Kirke (737)** XX⁵. To every child of the said Henry & Joane Kirke 5/-. To Dorothie wife of George Mather my grandchild 10/-. To **Arnolde (738)** the son of **Henry Kirke (737)** my grandchild two cofers, etc and all bedsteads except one pair which my son **Thomas Hall (649)** is to have.

To William Clewley my tenant 2/6 and to Ellen his wife 6/8 and to every of their children XII^d each. To my cousin **John Hall**¹ 6/8 and to his wife 3/4 and to every of their children 1/-. To my kinsman Walter Rose £5. To Roger Harderne of Hilderstone 20/-. To **Nicholas Wright** of Coulton² 20/-. To my cosin Raphe Porter 10/- and to my cosin Anne his wife 10/- and to every one of their children 2/- each.

To my cosin John Hill 3/4 and to my cosin Elizabeth his wife. To my cosin Agnes Wright of Mothershall 6/8. To the poor of Stone XX⁵. To the poor of Hilderston and Fulford³ XX⁵.

To my goddaughter Mary Johnson 10/-. To my sister **Elizabeth Bennet (667)** 3/4. Residue to **Thomas Hall (649)** my son. My son⁴ **Raphe Porter (739)** to have the keeping of any deeds that I may have and that shall concern my said son **Thomas Hall (649)**.

Executors, the said **Raphe Porter (739)** and **Henry Kirke (737)** my son in law. Overseers my cosin John Hall of Spott and my cosin Thomas Launder.
Witnesses:- Richard Hurdman and William Welde.

By a Codicil he gives £10 to be invested and the interest to be given to twelve poor men, four to be of Kibbleston⁵ and the rest of Fulford and Sherley to be distributed at the discretion of my son in law **Henry Kirke (737)** and my neighbour John Shalcross.

Proved at Lichfield by both Executors 17 January 1636-7
