Thomas Hall (649) of Spott Grange co. Stafford, yeoman.

Will dated 1 April 1658. To be buried in the Church of Stone

To my wife **Sarah (650)** half my lands in the Spott Grange and Blackhill (bought of John Povey, gent) for her life. To eldest son **John Hall (673)**, the other half of said lands when he attains 21, he to pay to my younger children **Thomas (647)**, **Marie (675)** and **William (674)**, £40 each at 21.

To my son **John (673)** at 21 two pieces of land, bought of Sampson Wright late of Hilderstone, called the New Leasowe and the Faire Flatt he to pay £60 equally amongst my said younger children.

Residue to my said three younger children

Executrix my said wife **Sarah (650)**

Overseers:-Thomas Porter and **William Hall**

Inventory dated 16 April 1661

Appraisers- Jeffrey Bagnald, Raphe Porter, Thomas Porter and William Hall

Proved at Lichfield 22 May 1661 by the sole executrix

In the name of God Amen, I shew the first day of December in the year of our Lord God one thousand six hundred fifty and eight. I Thomas Hall of Spottisgrange in the County of Staffe your loving in God and good memory (God bee praised) doe make and ordaine this my last will and Testament in manner and forme following, viz. /

I bequeath my soule to Almighty God, and my body to be buried in Christian buriall
yett the parish church of Stone in the County of Staffe aforesaid. /

Item I give and bequeath unto my wellbeloved wife Anna Hall the moiety, or one halfe
of my Lande in Spottisgrange and Blarkehill formerly bought of John Fawcett, your
for and duringe the terme of her naturall life. /

Item I give and bequeath the other moiety, or halfe of my Lande in Spottisgrange and Blarkehill
aforesaid unto John Hall my eldest Sonne if he shall live and attaine to the age of one and
twenty years, if he should die the said John pay unto my younger children Thomas,
James, and William the summe of ffortie pounde a peece of Lawfull money of
England as they shall live and attaine to the severall ages of one and twenty years, and
in case any of them shall dye before hee or they shall attaine to the age of one and twenty
years as aforesaid, his, her, or thiers pte shall bee equally distributed to such child
or children as shall live and attaine to the age aforesaid, And my will and mynde is
further my wife beinge wth child att the makinge hereof that if it happen the said
child live and attaine likewise to the age of one and twenty years, the said John
shall pay likewise ffortie pounde of Lawfull money of England unto that child. /

Item I give and bequeath unto my Sonne John so soon as he shall attaine to the age of one and
twenty years the summe of two hundred of Land bought of Sampson Wright Latt of
Lidderston Commonly called the New Leasow and the flaine flat, upon condition the said John shall
pay the summe of threescore pounde of Lawfull English money to be equally divided to
such younger child or children as shall live duringe: Or else the said two hundred
of Land to bee and remaine to the use and behoofe of such younger child or children
for ever. /

I give and bequeath and my will and mynde is, that my said wife Anna Hall have the Disposicion
of all my realt estate and Chattels untill my eldest Sonne John shall attaine to the age of one and
twenty years full, if he should die he should be bound to paye the same, and if it happen the said
Anna shall receive the said summe of two hundred pounde a peece unto so many younger children
as shall live duringe. /

Item my will and mynde is that so soon as my Sonne John shall attaine to one and twenty years full
as aforesaid, he shall have the hold in the plow, wth the furniture thereto belonging, and entere to
his owne use of one halfe of all woodden household stuffe and husbandrie ware, and the other pte after
the decesse of the said Anna his mother. /

Item I give and bequeath and my will and mynde is, after my funerall expenses are defrayed and my
debts payed, that what money shall be over and above shall bee equally divided amongst such
younger child or children as shall live duringe. /

Item I constitute and ordaine my wellbeloved wife Anna Hall my Executrix, and Thomas Fawcett
and William Hall Overseers. /
