 not hereafter appear any Lawful Lett or Impediment, by reason
 of any Pre-contract, Consanguinity, Affinity, or any other just Cause
 whatsoever; but that *Richard Hall, & John Woodcock*
both of the Parish of ~~Elstow~~ Ellistow
in the County of Stafford

may lawfully Marry together; And that there is not any Suit depending
 before any Judge Ecclesiastical or Civil, for or concerning any such Pre-
 contract; And that the Consent of the Parents, or others the Governors
 of the said Parties, be thereunto first had and obtain'd; And that they
 cause their said Marriage to be openly solemnized in the Face of the
 Parish Church of *Walsingham, or Marchington*
 between the Hours of Eight and Twelve of the Clock in the Forenoon;
 And do and shall save harmless and keep indemnified the abovenam'd
Doctor Henry Raynes his Surrogates, and all other
 his Officers, and Successors in Office, for and concerning the Premises:
 That Then this Obligation to be Void and of none Effect, or else to re-
 main in full Force and Virtue.
