MALKIN FAMILY BIBLE

Inscriptions, mostly longhand, some shorthand, on front and back endpapers of the Malkin family Bible (in possession of (Alexander Bernard Malkin of Urase Lane, Tittensor, Stoke-on-Trent, Staffordshire, ST12 9HH - only son of James Bernard Malkin and Gertrude Malkin, née Groom, and only grandson of Elijah Malkin (RN271) and Nellie née Hall (RN168)) which was presented in 1839 to Elijah Malkin, grandfather of RN271 - relating to births marriages and deaths between 1794 and 1895 and including some notes of voyages between 1884 and 1895.

I have made additional notes in *italics*.

1. Gold lettered presentation label (red Morocco leather) pasted on to "marbled" outer end paper at front.

Joe [931] went to Didsbury College 13 September 1887

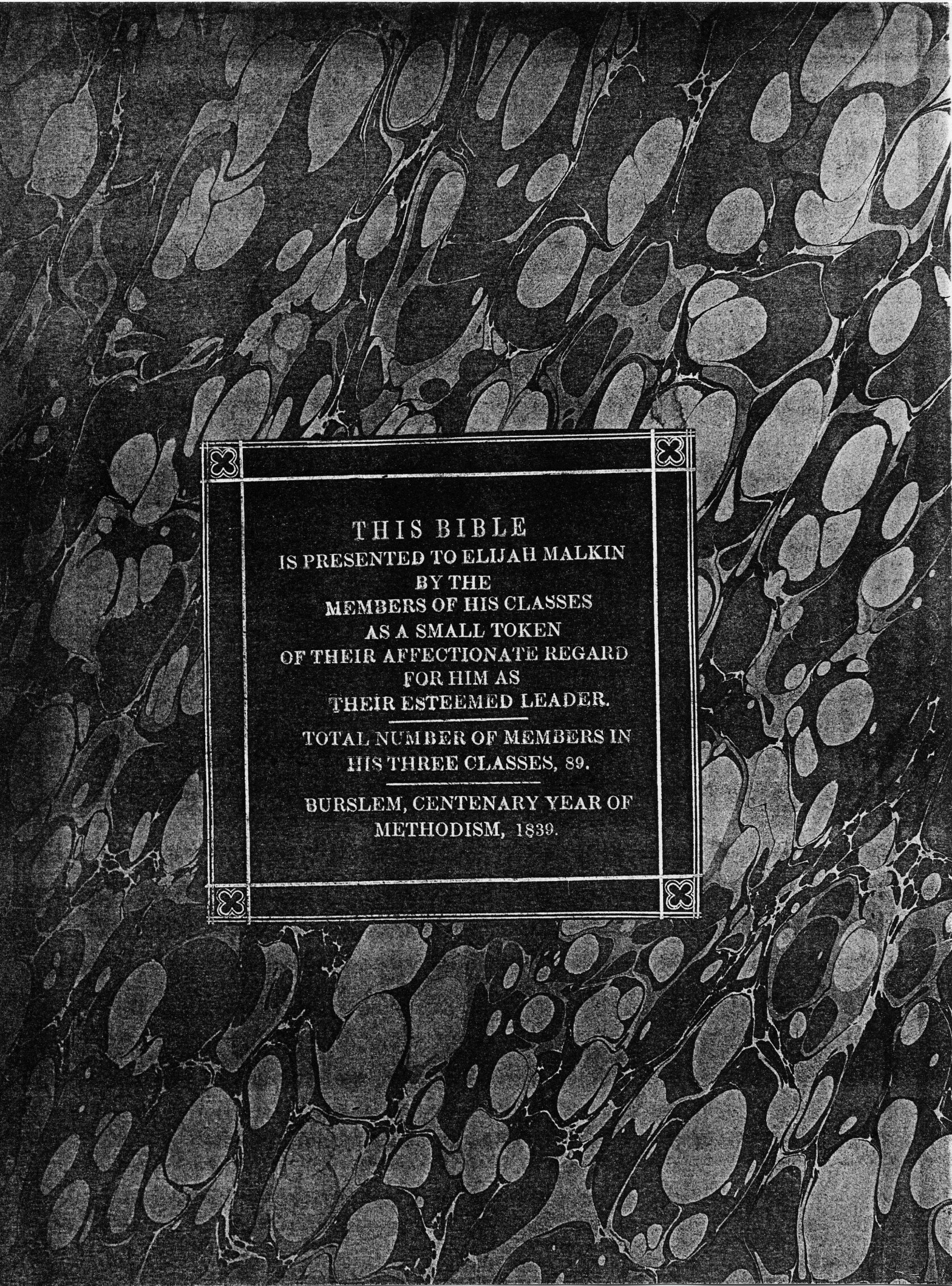
Fred [932] arrived from Canada 1 January 1891 and returned February.
