Inscriptions on two Hall graves in Kingsley Churchyard

1. In Loving Memory of John Hall of The Sycamores, Whiston who died July 3rd 1888 aged 82 years and of Catherine his wife who died 11th April 1892 aged 71 years and of Elizabeth, beloved wife of George Smith and daughter of the above, who died December 13th 1917 aged 68 years and of George Smith her husband who died March 9th 1923 aged 71 years.
2. In Loving Memory of Catherine ('Katie'), wife of the Reverend Edward Smith, Wesleyan Minister and daughter of John and Catherine Hall of Whiston, who died at Fairfield, Manchester September 1st 1883 aged 32 years, also of Edith Thompson [Smith] daughter of the above who died April 22nd 1884 aged 8 months, also of Anne, eldest daughter of John and Catherine Hall, who died December 3rd 1915 aged 70 years.

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
